

Where to Refill Your Bottle (Without the Plastic Guilt)

1. Ask the Crew for Safe Drinking Water

Your crew is your best resource!

2. Refill at Cafés or Restaurants Ashore

Many local spots are happy to help. Order a coffee, enjoy the view, and politely ask to refill your bottle with filtered or bottled water.

3. Refills in Select Marinas

Athens marinas, in particular, are a safe option: tap water in Athens is clean, regularly tested, and perfectly safe to drink. Whether you are at Alimos Marina, Lavrio, Flisvos, or Zeas, you can refill your LARQ bottle with confidence.

4. Athens Tap Water Is Safe

Unlike many Greek islands, tap water in Athens is safe to drink clean, regularly tested, and high-quality. That means you can refill your bottle almost anywhere in the city: hotels, restaurants, or even public refill points like the one in Korai Square.

Important Note: While the **LARQ** bottle features UV-C purification technology that helps neutralize bacteria and viruses, the tap water onboard is still **not safe for drinking**. The bottle does not make non-potable water drinkable—so please **do not fill it directly from the tap**.
